Overall control and decision making.

The mark must reflect the referee’s overall level of control, accuracy of decision making and management of and communication with players. When deciding on a mark consideration should be given to such aspects of the referee’s performance as: impartiality, fitness, positioning, signalling, use of advantage, handling of major incidents.

A mark between 91 and 100 would be regarded as ‘excellent’

A mark between 71 and 90 would represent the standard expected.

A mark between 51 and 70 would represents a reasonably accurate performance, but with a few shortcomings.

Our club awards an overall mark of out of 100. Before making this decision, check the above summaries first.

When awarding a mark of **50** or less, an explanation must be provided in the box below, and sent to the League Secretary, with comments, which could help the referee improve future performances. Use an extra page, if space provided in insufficient.
